

School Counselor Fellows Program

Our model recognizes four major overlapping areas of need for the 2020 school year. Selected fellows will develop plans to address (1) the COVID-19 pandemic response, (2) student mental health and wellness, (3) economic and workforce impacts, and (4) racial inequities and injustice within their school and community. We will work collaboratively to prioritize areas of the most urgent need for participating fellows.

The school counselor fellowship will focus on urgent and timely issues impacting school counselor practice. Fellows will investigate how the pandemic, mental health & wellness and equity driven practices influence college and career readiness and postsecondary planning. Action oriented plans will be developed to increase practices that best support students as they navigate their postsecondary path in an erratic and changing environment.
